Kansas City Chief and native sone returns home to host youth football camp

Port Saint Lucie – Albert Wilson, starting wide receiver for the Kansas City Chiefs and Port St. Lucie High School graduate, will host what he hopes will become an annual youth football camp from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m., June 25, at Lawnwood Stadium, Fort Pierce.

The football camp is part of a three-day celebrity weekend to launch the Albert Wilson Foundation, which will provide services and resources to youth in foster care in Okeechobee and the Treasure Coast.

"This weekend give me the opportunity to give back to the city that gave so much to me," said Wilson, who spent much of his youth in local foster care. "It's an opportunity to have a postitive impact in the lives of youth and also make a difference in my community."

The camp will create an environment for kids to learn the game of football and develop teamwork skills.

Coaches for the day include players from the Kansas City Chiefs, the Cleveland Browns and other NFL teams to be announced later.

The camp is free to children, ages 5-17, but registration is limited to 150, and participants will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.

Lunch and t-shirts will be provided, said Keith Lewis, camp director.

"All they have to do is get there," he said.
