Policy

The policy of Communities Connected for Kids (CCKids) is consistent with that of the Department of Children and Families Operating Procedure, 175-65. Under no circumstances will any employee or subcontract agency of Devereux Community Based Care of Okeechobee and the Treasure Coast

seek a Do Not Resuscitate (DNR) order.

Procedure

- 1. Communities Connected for Kids and its Case Management Organizations (CMO) will not seek a Do Not Resuscitate (DNR) order.
- 2. In the event a parent or Guardian ad Litem (GAL) wishes to seek a DNR order, the assigned Dependency Case Manager (DCM) will inform the parent or GAL to seek legal counsel, unless a Termination of Parental Rights (TPR) order has been entered. The DCM will document this request and instruction in the file chronological and FSFN.
- If a DNR order is approved, a copy of the finalized DNR Order will be sent to CCKids, after which the recipient will notify other members of the management team, and the CCKids Chief Executive Officer.
- 4. The DCM will be notified and as well as the appropriate medical practitioner by the recipient of the finalized DNR Order.
 - 5. The DNR will become a part of the case file.
