WHAT'S NEW?

- On the Adoption Information page, users will be able to capture if an Adoptive Parent is a Fictive Kin. The word "other" was removed when selecting Relative or Non-Relative as the relationship of the Adoptive Parent to the Child.
- All pre-existing pages with "Stepparent" selected will remain displayed. Once deselected, the user must select a new relationship type.
- A value must be selected for Relationship of Adoptive Parent to Child.

- New adoption pages will not show the values of Independent Parent and Birth Parent.
